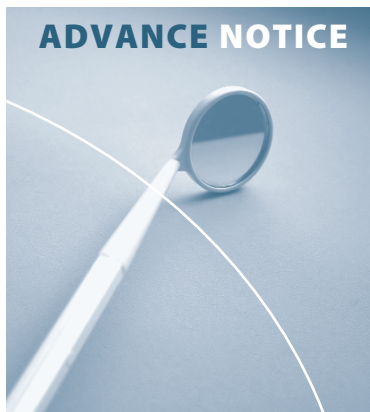


## ADVANCE NOTICE
